Too Good to Be a Scam

Is there more to life than this? What's my purpose? Is there a God, and does He have a plan for my life? Over the last several weeks a couple dozen people have gathered to ask and answer some of life's most significant questions at Alpha.

We've explored ideas and thoughts about each of these questions and many in the course have learned the purpose of Jesus' life and his death on the cross. Perhaps the most frequently asked question, however, from my time running Alpha has been "But why would Jesus give us such an important gift, completely free?"

The Apostle Paul writes in Ephesians "God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God" (Ephesians 2:8). He goes on to say that there are no visible works or actions you can take to earn this gift.

Many skeptical people rightfully get squeamish when they hear of a free gift, since most "free" things either have a catch or are a scam.

I decided to clean out my spam folder a few weeks ago and I was shocked to find thousands of emails from Nigerian princes, businessmen with "proposals" and subject lines that read "FREE GOLD NOW."

There was even one from my grandmother that read "I need you to do me a favor. Can you send an Amazon gift card for me from your account. I'll pay you back later."

To be sure, they were all scam emails. But the message from my grandmother concerned me. After calling to confirm that the email wasn't from her she discovered her account had been hacked.

I assured her that none of her friends would be gullible enough to fall for this, and surely no one would blindly send Amazon gift cards to an unknown source without checking with her first.

And you think – no one is gullible enough to fall for that. Until you hear of someone who does. To my surprise, she called me back shortly after to say that one of her friends had responded. She had sent \$200 worth of Amazon gift cards to a scammer with no way to get the money back!

And we're so suspicious that we think God is offering this free gift through Jesus. There must be a catch. Or, this must be a scam.

But there isn't. The gift is free. The gift is grace. The gift is Jesus.

But while it might be free, it isn't cheap. It cost Jesus tremendously as he sacrificed his life for you and me on a cross. This is the truth of the Gospel and the truth we have been learning through Alpha.

Indeed, it wasn't cheap for Jesus and it isn't cheap for those who believe either. Jesus says those who want to become his disciples must both consider the cost and give up their former life (Luke 14).

But incredibly, the promise of God's free gift is that a life with Jesus is worth more than anything it might cost you.
